Biography

Henk Jan Dalewijk is psychiatrist/psychoanalyst and works in private practice after retirement from a leading job in a large psychiatric/psychotherapeutic organization. At the moment he is mainly active in consultation in organizational, administrative and ethical/disciplinary matters. He has been active in the development of Permanent Professional Development programs and for many and different organizations he has been, and still is, active in organizing workshops, conferences and congresses, mainly on Psychotherapy, Psychoanalysis and Personality Disorders. In total he has published over one hundred papers. He has been board member, usually as Chair or President, of many organizations and among many other things he has been active in the setting-up and functioning of disciplinary courts, in which he has participated himself over many years. Together with Hellinga and van Luyn he published, 'Personalities, Master Clinicians confront the treatment of Borderline Personality Disorders' in 2005. The book 'Severe Personality Disorders' by Van Luyn, Akhtar and Livesley was written as a tribute to his work on the development of training programs in psychiatry and psychotherapy. After publishing 'The Symfora Tapes', a set of DVD's showing the work of master clinicians in daily practice, he received an award from the International Society of Transference Focused Psychotherapy (ISTFP).
